Background check forms are required for anyone working with preschoolers. The forms have to be renewed every three years. Preschool Ministry includes birth through kindergarten. Parents of preschoolers are expected to volunteer in one or more of the preschool ministry areas on a regular basis, except in extenuating circumstances.

SUNDAY MORNING

9:45am Classes

Preschool Classes meet weekly at 9:45am on Sundays year round. Teaching/volunteer positions require a background check.

These leaders volunteer every week during the year. There are opportunities to serve in an assistant type role or as a substitute for this hour. Our goal is to have a minimum of 3 leaders per class each week.

Extended Teaching Care and Preschool Worship at 11am

Extended Teaching Care is provided by volunteers on a rotation of once a month for our Baby and Toddler Classes.

Preschool Worship is provided for our Twos, Threes, and Fours classes. Small group leaders serve once a month and help lead in small group review of the lesson taught by a lead teacher.

AWANA

Awana is a Bible-based program where children ages two through the 5th Grade learn to memorize and apply the word of God to their lives on a weekly basis in an engaging atmosphere. Preschoolers participate in: large group, small group and recreation time throughout the evening. We need a variety of workers to lead Awana.

SPECIAL EVENTS (Example: Vacation Bible School)

Throughout the year, there are a variety of special events planned for preschoolers and their families. These events are advertised in the worship folder, on social media, e-newsletters, and on the website.

The largest of these events is our annual **Vacation Bible School (VBS)**. In VBS, preschoolers often learn and experience different cultures or environments while learning about God's plan for their lives.

GUEST SERVICES TEAM

VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL (VBS)

Vacation Bible School is a special week, during the summer, for preschoolers and children. Mix together the key ingredients: The Bible, fun, 100 excited volunteers, prayer, and lots of children—and you have everything you need for a grand VBS.

The entire church family can get involved by serving in areas that match your special talents. Positions include: department directors, teachers, helpers, team members for: curriculum, games, crafts, snacks, publicity, promotion, enlistment, decorations, stage design, childcare, outreach visitors, follow-up, supply purchasers, greeters, secretaries, money counters, mission offering, clean-up, family celebration, and prayer warriors.

PRAYER LEADERS

Commit to pray for our students individually and as a group on a weekly basis.

SUNDAY LIFE GROUP LEADERS 9:45am

Disciple a small group of middle or high school students. Each group is assigned at least two leaders. Your commitment involves leading a Bible Study and facilitating discussion each Sunday during a connection hour, shepherding your group through consistent involvement in their lives and prayer, and following up with visitors.

This commitment also includes participating in Wednesday Night Student Worship in some role (some exceptions allowed) and attending all leader gatherings and trainings.

WEDNESDAY NIGHT VOLUNTEERS 6:15pm

Guest Services

Greet students each week before student worship, helping them sign in with our software. Welcome new students that attend, registering their information in our software, giving them a gift bag, and connecting them with some peers and other adult leaders.

SMALL GROUP LEADERS

After the middle school message, lead a small group of students in prayer and discussion.

TEACH

Be prepared to teach by researching the text diligently, along with meditation and prayer over the Bible text. Communicate clearly and passionately.

MENTOR

Lead by example in a consistent, obedient walk. Plan group activities when possible and be available for one-on-one time with students.

Be real and transparent as you walk through life issues, with the students, as opportunities are presented.

GREETER

This role is essential as you will be the one who students will, most likely, see first. Students may be distracted or distant due to being sleep deprived, too busy, or they may simply be introverted. Don't be intimidated - they will, most likely, remember the fact that you actually cared enough to initiate a conversation with them more than anything else. In this capacity, you may be able to reach a student and open a pathway to being a mentor that others cannot. As part of this, please help with making sure connect cards and class roles are completed and turned in. You are a vital part of this ministry!

CONNECTOR

This role is one of inreach and outreach. We have guests who we need to reach out to and establish a connection with. We also have students who have been involved that may have slipped away or could be fighting a battle that we are unaware of and they just need to know we care. We may have students who don't feel like they have a place in this ministry or stay in the shadows who just need encouragement to join in. Not only is this about connecting with these mentioned above, but also about encouraging our other students to be connectors as well. Building community, in this area, is one of our greatest tools in making disciples.

MEDIA AND TECH TEAM

The Media and Tech Team consist of audio, lighting, and projection. This is not simply a support ministry, it is a ministry itself. It is essential to what we do. It is also a place that helps students connect to this ministry. Students that may not be comfortable leading in song or word often times find their place in leading within this team. The adults helping in this area will help insure that things operate smoothly, but will also teach students how to serve through tech and media. This is one of the most effective areas in connecting with students.

STUDENT PRAISE BAND

If you are a student or adult who plays an instrument or sing, you can help the praise band lead worship on Wednesday nights. This commitment involves arriving early on Wednesday nights for sound-check and often, attending praise-team practices. Students and adults can serve in this role.

ROLES IN GENERAL

Regardless of the role in which you are called to serve, be committed to and passionate about Jesus and the Green Street Student Ministry. Mingle with students as they come in and make new students feel welcome. New people will feel out of place, some students will feel left out. Participate in student functions wholeheartedly and draw those students in that might be reluctant to participate. Whether it's Sunday morning, Wednesday night or another scheduled event, things start when the first student arrives. Have fun and engage them!

STUDENT AND COLLEGE HOST FAMILIES

Families who are willing to invest in high school, college students & young adults lives by providing a safe place for out-of-town students during the school year. They will open their homes to the students for meals, Bible studies, and general gatherings.

3.....You can join a Rotation of Prayer Intercessors who will pray during our services on Sunday mornings. We will select a room with a TV feed from the service and we need 4-5 people to pray as the service is going on in the Worship Center. With enough volunteers, we can set it up so that you only pray once a month during a service, or you can pray for a service and attend the other service.
